- 3. What was the role of the tyrant in Greek society?
- 4. Why is Herodotus considered the father of history?
- 5. Compare and contrast the philosophies of Socrates, Plato, and Aristotle.
- 6. Why is Alexander of Macedonia "Great"?
- 7. Why did Alexander's empire collapse so quickly after his death?
- 8. What was the political system for Rome under the Republic?
- 9. What made Roman armies so successful?
- 10. What caused the Roman Republic to fall and be replaced by the Empire?
- 11. Compare and contrast Caesar and Octavian.
- 12. What was the Pax Romana and why is it significant?
- 13. What caused the fall of Rome?
- 14. Compare and contrast Christianity from the dozens of other cult faiths in Rome.
- 15. Compare and contrast Islam with the other monotheistic faiths?
- 16. How did the Carolingians come to power?
- 17. Why is Charlemagne considered one of the great leaders of history? What did he accomplish?
- 18. What role did the church play in society during Charlemagne's reign?
- 19. What happened to Charlemagne's empire after his death? Why is this significant?
